And we would like to remind you of the comments by Madame Justice Sue Cooper in August 2010:

Madam Justice Sue Cooper ruled that “I am satisfied that Inuit in the five affected communities will suffer irreparable harm if an injunction is not granted.” The five communities are the Arctic hamlets of Pond Inlet, Arctic Bay, Grise Fiord, Resolute Bay and Clyde River

“If the testing proceeds as planned and marine mammals are impacted as Inuit say they will be, the harm to Inuit in the affected communities will be significant and irreversible,” Judge Cooper wrote.

“The loss extends not just to the loss of a food source, but to loss of a culture. No amount of money can compensate for such loss.”
