Baffin Island is full of wildlife that are abundant, to do a seismic testing would be very dangerous to our wildlife. Especially including all the various marine mammals, such as different kinds of seals, whales. Since it is the ocean the acoustics under water are many times louder than being in the air outside of water. My husband knows for he has seen seals with bleeding ears, and he has seen seals that are deaf to outboard motors, that what we have been seeing. Seismic testing if also very dangerous to other smaller wildlife and organisms such as scalpins, shrimps, krills and other vertebrae, I know this because my husband is a hunter himself and he report what he had seen every time, and we sustain from wildlife.

I would be able to agree to siesmic testing now, but only after twenty five years have passed. original signed
It is crazy because we need narwhal for food and we need them to life, for living, and we need them to see people hunt too.
